

SALE OF BANK REAL ESTATE

Bids Received Yesterday for a Large Number of Parcels at the G. H. Umbesen Auction.

Bids aggregating about \$133,000 were received yesterday for the properties of the Hibernia Savings and Loan Society offered at auction by G. H. Umbesen & Co.
