for the first concert of Earplay's 2012 season next Monday

Veteran San Francisco ensemble Earplay, noted for its "lyrical and ferocious" performances of new chamber music, kicks off its 27^{th} concert season on February 6, with works by Morton Feldman, Alex Hills, Mauricio Rodriguez, Wayne Peterson and Chen Yi. The 7:30 p.m. concert is at Herbst Theatre, 401 Van Ness Avenue in San Francisco.

American composer Morton Feldman, Earplay's featured composer this season, is represented in the opening concert by *Nature Pieces*, his 1951 piece for solo piano. Alex Hills' 1958-1961 is the world premiere performance of a 2011 Earplay commission. Also a world premiere, *Crepitum* by Mauricio Rodriguez was co-commissioned in 2010 by Earplay and the San Francisco Foundation Fund for Artists. *Excursions*, a 2011 composition by Wayne Peterson, marks a third world premiere, and Chen Yi's 2007 work *Tunes from My Home* rounds out the program in its first U.S. performance.
